- 2023 Budget highlights: We have increased recurring plate contributions by 5K. We have increased recurring contributions by 50K. General Fund Raising is budgeted at 5K. Diocesan Fair Share remains about the same. Supply Clergy and organist expenses are up somewhat—approximately \$500 per week for section leaders. Fr. Chase acknowledges that these are aggressive, but he feels these are achievable goals. He feels we need to invest in the health and vitality of the church now.
