In God's reign, there is no distinction between the mighty and the lowly, between the powerful and the vulnerable, between the holy and the human. God sees in us all our needs and our possibilities. And the possibility among even the least of us is that because God has become human in Jesus Christ, we humans can become more fully the image of divine love we were created to be.
