*"Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord!
Hosanna in the highest heaven!" (Matthew 21:9)*

Pilate said to them, "Then what should I do with Jesus who is called the Messiah?" All of them said, "Let him be crucified!" (Matthew 27:22)

Holy Week is the Church's yearly pilgrimage with Jesus to the foot of the Cross and to the Empty Tomb. Holy Week begins and ends in joy, but between Palm Sunday's Triumphant Entry into Jerusalem and the Resurrection of Easter, we walk with Jesus on his journey toward the cross. Excited shouts of "Hosanna" to a long-awaited messiah give way to angry demands for a violent execution.

Holy Week is about remembrance, but not just sharing a memory. We re-member the story by placing ourselves in the midst of the events, through our liturgies. We worship an incarnate God, a God who became human, and as we walk with Jesus, we become a part of the story. The Crucifixion and Resurrection were events in history, but they also come alive inside us and in the midst of our community when we remember them.

The walk through Holy Week can be very emotional. Please do reach out if you would like to talk about any of the services, both what to expect and if you would like to process afterward. Blessings to you on this journey. The experience of new life at Easter will be all the richer for the time you take to walk toward the Cross.

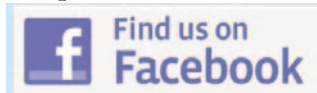
